Phase 1: Screening

Since we are asking you to be in a research study, we want to tell you about it.

Someone in your family has diabetes. This means you have a greater chance of getting diabetes too. Diabetes makes people sick. Diabetes happens when there is not enough insulin in your body. Insulin is needed to give your body energy to run and play.

We can find out more about your chance of getting diabetes. To do this, we would need to stick your arm with a needle to do a blood test. This could sting and you could be sore or have a bruise afterwards. Sometimes we would need to do this a second time in order to be sure of the results. If we find that you have more of a chance of getting diabetes, we will ask you and your parents if you want to continue in this research study. We will also ask you and your parents if we can save some of your blood sample to test later.

We hope this research study will help us to understand how people get diabetes. The study could also help us learn more about preventing diabetes. Being in this study is a free choice. You do not have to be in this study and if you do, you can change your mind and stop the study. No one will get mad at you if you do not want to be in the study.

If we find out that you are not likely to get diabetes now, you still might have a chance of getting it later. So we will ask you to come back once a year to repeat the blood test. Please ask any questions you might have.
