

Instructions for Writing a Letter of Recommendation

Dear Faculty Member:

The Life Sciences Summer Undergraduate Research Programs (LSSURP) provides intensive research and structured learning experiences. In completing this recommendation please bear in mind that a major objective of this program is to help the participant prepare for graduate studies.

Please submit a letter and comment briefly on the following about the applicant:

- Their interactions as an individual and team player;
- Their ability to contribute to and benefit from an undergraduate research experience;
- Their maturity level, ability to complete a commitment, and participate in a residential program;
- Discuss areas in which the applicant needs to improve, as well as his/her strengths.

Instructions for Submitting Recommendation Letter

Please send the letter as a **PDF attachment** to lssurp@umn.edu. Please save the document with the students' last name, first name and then your initials.

For example, Professor Colin Campbell is submitting a letter for Evelyn Juliussen. The document would be saved as follows: JuliussenEvelynCC.pdf. To convert document to pdf, please visit this website for easy instructions, <http://www.adobe.com/acom/createpdf/>

We need to receive the letter from your e-mail address. We will NOT accept any letters from students. We will NOT accept letters of recommendations in print form.

Please be aware that the student must submit all their application materials by February 1, 2020.
