

## WHAT IS A LONGITUDINAL INTEGRATED CLERKSHIP?

A Longitudinal Integrated Clerkship (LIC) is a clerkship in which medical students participate in the comprehensive care of patients, *their patients*, over time.

LICs allow for continuity of relationships with patients, continuity of relationships with preceptors and continuity with the health care system.

Through experiences in the LIC, students meet the majority of the year's core clinical competencies across multiple disciplines simultaneously.

### IMPORTANT DATES

- Application due December 15, 2014
- Interviews in January 2015
- Notification of acceptance into program in February 2015
- Clerkship starts Period 3 (8/24/15) and runs through intersession (5/27/16)
  - 40 week clerkship
  - 4 weeks of vacation time
- Pre-requisite of OB/GYN or Pediatrics prior to starting clerkship.

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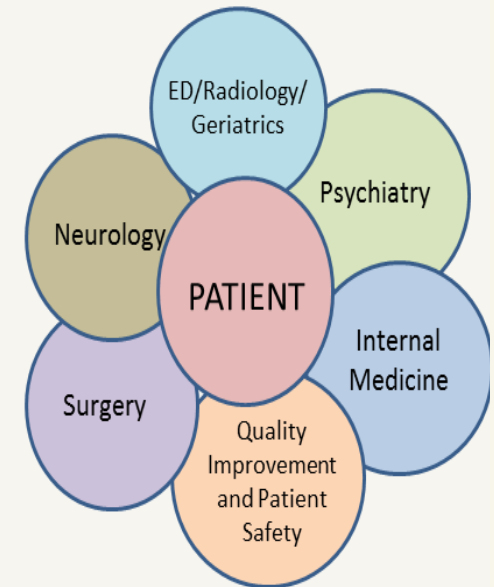
